

RIDE & RIDDEN 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON PASO ROBLES

TASTING NOTES:

Possessing bravado with a focus of blackberry freshness and mocha. Dusty, plum skin tannins ride side saddle with dense notes of leather and tobacco. It's yippee ki yay on the palate with a juicy, yet muscular profile.

WINERY INFO:

Ride and Ridden Wine Co. is a new project from Maayan Koschitzky, Director of Winemaking at Atelier Melka) and his protogé Remington Jorgensen, who joins Ride & Ridden Wine Co. from Alejandro Bulgheroni Estate, after an impressive series of stages at the likes of Château de Beaucastel, Rajat Parr's Domaine de la Côte, and Opus One.

As a young winemaker with vision, she is fully prepared to take us to the next level in both quality and volume in the coming years. Her background, knowledge and drive make her the perfect addition to our growing team.

Ride and Ridden is focused on producing three separate Cabernet Sauvignon's from three different regions

PRESTON VINEYARDS 2019 'L. PRESTON' RED WINE DRY CREEK VALLEY, SONOMA

TASTING NOTES:

The 2019 L. Preston Red is ready to drink out of the gate, with complex aromatics of mulberry, plum, licorice, pepper and fresh leather. The wine is sleek and alluring in the mouth, carried by Grenache notes of stewed ripe strawberries and finishing with sweet, resolved tannin.

WINERY INFO:

Preston Farm and Winery is a family-operated, organic property in Healdsburg's Dry Creek Valley. Our 125 acres are nestled between a meandering salmon-spawning stream and a sleepy stretch of former wagon trail leading to town. Under 45 years of stewardship by our family, the land has evolved from an emphasis on wine alone to diversified crops including vineyards, vegetables, fruit and olive trees, grain, and pastured livestock. Our estate winery features a tasting room and farm store. Estate-pressed olive oil, whole grain sourdough loaves, pickles, and produce from the farm are seasonally available for purchase along with the wines.

In 2018 we took a literal chainsaw to one of our Syrah blocks, cutting off the heads and grafting them to some lesser-known varieties we've been experimenting with. With less Syrah on hand, you may have noticed the blend shifting in the L. Preston. Its always been a fairly accurate reflection, percentage-wise, of the red Rhone grapes we grow. Our new vineyard makeup is allowing the other grapes to play a more prominent role, with more Grenache & Cinsault bringing juicy, vibrant fruitiness to the higher register and Mourvedre adding length and depth underneath. The process of assembling the wine is more complex and its now more of a synergy of equals and less of a supporting act for the Syrah.

Composition: 28% Grenache, 27% Syrah, 26% Mourvedre, 12% Cinsaut, 7% Carignane
