

## BROOKS NOTE 2022 PINOT NOIR PETALUMA GAP, SONOMA

### TASTING NOTES:

Our 2022 Petaluma Gap Pinot Noir is beautiful medium ruby color. It has a bouquet of nutmeg, vanilla, baked black cherry, earthy sage and wet stone. It has a silky entry and lovely, round mouth feel with flavors of dark cherry, berry compote, sage, bay tree and baking spice. It has a long, lingering finish with dark cherry, berries, a little leather, subtle tannins and fresh acidity.

### WINERY INFO:

Brooks Note is a small, family winery focused on making balanced, elegant wines from the hidden corners of California Wine Country. We strive to make wines that showcase the diverse terroirs that we source from. That means picking grapes earlier and using less new oak in the cellar than many winemakers in California. Brooks Note also takes pride in digging a little deeper for the vineyards we source from.

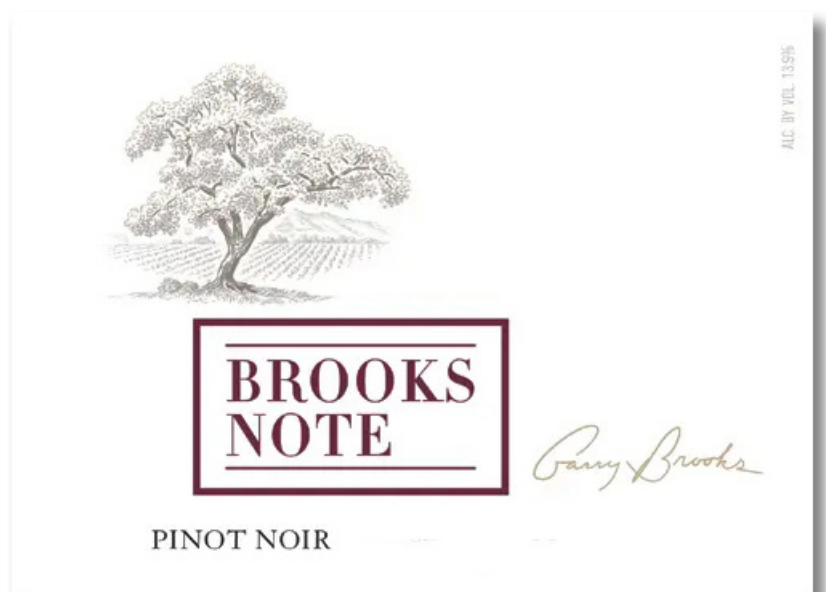

## PEAKE RANCH 2020 PINOT NOIR PEAKE RANCH VINEYARD STA RITA HILLS, SANTA BARBARA

### TASTING NOTES:

The 2020 Pinot Noir Peake Ranch Vineyard comes from the estate vineyard on the eastern side of the appellation and was destemmed and brought up in 32% new French oak. This medium-bodied effort has a seamless, focused mouthfeel as well as terrific aromatics that lead toward the red and black-fruited, iron, and spice[1]driven spectrum. I love its purity of fruit, it stays relatively tight and chiseled on the palate, and it has a great finish. It's going to drink nicely for 10-12+ years.

### WINERY INFO:

John and Gill Wagner live part time in Los Angeles and spend the rest of their time at Peake Ranch. John grew up in Ventura County working on his family's lemon and avocado orchards. He attended UCLA and completed a Bachelor's and Master's in Physics. John pursued a career in finance, but always wanted to return to agriculture. He has completed the UC Davis Certificate in Winemaking. Gillian was born in England but has lived in the States for many years. Gill serves on several philanthropic boards, the most important relating to the unhoused in Los Angeles. John and Gill have two sons, Tom and Joe.

Their connection with the Santa Barbara wine world began when they fell in love with the beautiful countryside, the amazing hospitality of 'wine' people and, of course, the wonderful wine of the region. Their commitment was sealed when they purchased Peake Ranch and built a winery and a small house on the property.

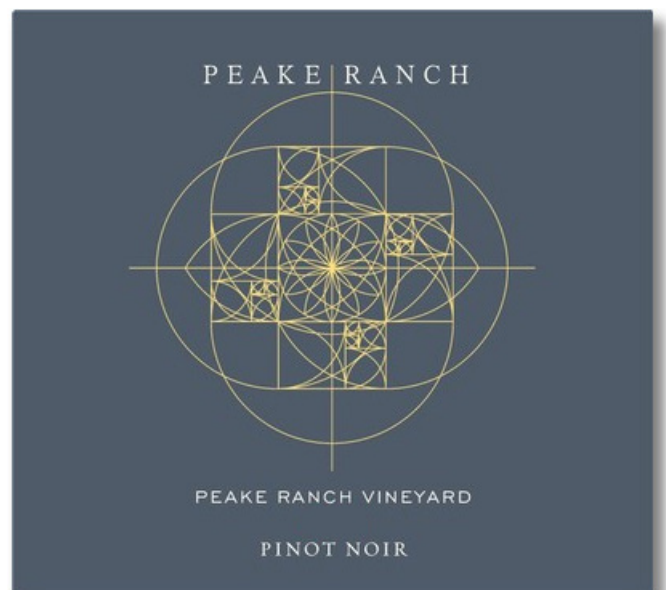
