
CLUB CRUSH RED April Shipment (#2-2024)

PEAKE RANCH 2020 'BELLIS NOIR' STA RITA HILLS

TASTING NOTES:

This wine is an homage to Daisy, our beloved winery dog. Daisy is a huge part of our family, as well as the entire Peake Ranch team. As for the name, Bellis (Bella in Latin) with Noir, representing the red, dark qualities of this wine, Bellis Noir is a blend that combines the brightness of Grenache with the brooding aspect of Syrah. The 2020 Bellis Noir opens with ripe strawberries and blueberries on the nose. A delightful expression of bold tannins and intricate notes of cocoa powder and almond surface on the palate and carry to the signature silky finish.



WINERY INFO:

The Peake Ranch property is nestled in the Sta. Rita Hills of Santa Barbara County on the winding, pastoral bluffs of Buellton. Our charming tasting room offers a variety of experiences, including intimate indoor seating arrangements and a large outdoor patio overlooking our beautiful vista of rolling hillsides and vineyards. Once owned by famed artist Channing Peake, the ranch will delight guests with the historic tasting room which was notably portrayed in the film Sideways. Located on the eastern end of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA on Santa Rosa Road, Peake Ranch is a 105-acre parcel with 50 acres of vines. The plantings include seven different clones of Pinot Noir, three clones of Chardonnay and two each of Syrah and Grenache. The plantings are all along a hill that covers most of the ranch, exposing the vines to the cool air that comes off the Pacific and into the Santa Ynez Valley. The combination of North, South, East and West facing slopes coupled with the exposure to varying degrees of the cool wind give the vineyard a diversity of fruit flavor profiles that is unique for a ranch of our size.

CROSSHATCH WINES 2019 'DEPTH' SANTA YNEZ VALLEY

TASTING NOTES:


Artists create "Depth" in their work by utilizing light and dark regions in an image to allow the piece to truly captivate its audience in an interesting and unique way. The co-fermentation of these two Bordeaux varietals yields contrasting flavors of soft baked plum, and vibrant, spicy earthiness of radish and root vegetables. There is a hit of green pepper on the nose together with baking spices. The rich and velvet-like palate feel of the Merlot blends beautifully between the rugged and organic feel of the Cabernet Franc. This blend reveals its unique power midpalate and gently winds down into a delicate and mellow finish.

WINERY INFO:

CrossHatch was created in 2011 by winemaker Ryan Carr. After making only single varietal wines for eleven years, Ryan wanted to try something different. He and his wife Jessica

came up with the idea for CrossHatch, inspired by the classic form of art. Every bottle from CrossHatch Winery is handcrafted as a co-fermented blend sourced from Santa Barbara County vineyards. A small production winery, only 1000 cases are produced each year. It began with the idea of cross hatching—an artistic technique that uses closely spaced intersecting lines to create shading, definition, and form in a drawing. We took this technique and adapted it into the winemaking process by harvesting multiple varietals on the same day, then crushing and fermenting them together. This elevates and creates flavors in the wine that would not have existed otherwise. Some of the best and oldest wines in the world are made this way, and the microclimates of Santa Barbara add another rich layer that distinguishes our wines from any other. In 2023, Michelle Vautier was invited in as the new owner. Founder Ryan Carr continued on as head winemaker and is training Michelle in this craft so she can preserve the essence of CrossHatch while infusing it with her own deep passion and unique vision.
