TASTING NOTES:

The 2021 Holler attacks with a uniquely complex nose of black cherry, forest floor, toasted oak, vanilla and mineral. This all leads to a richly textured palate loaded with blueberries, black currants, earthy goodness, dark chocolate and sweet herbs, all swaddled in extra fine tannins. As always, the World's Best Cabernet Sauvignon for the money.

WINERY INFO:

Sparkman Cellars produce a portfolio of wines that, at its core, is focused on Rhône and Bordeaux varietals, handcrafted in an elegant, yet fully expressionistic fashion. Simply put, our goal is to create wines that balance the finesse and earthiness of the old world and the power and richness of the new world, tasty wines that folks can enjoy now and, if they choose, for many years to come.

First produced in 2012, Holler is named for Red Hollow, the place where Chris's parents live in Knoxville, Tennessee. The theory behind the wine is simple: once the barrels for Kingpin, Rainmaker and Evermore are selected, the remaining barrels (plus some other Bordeaux varietals) become Holler. These barrels are good enough to become the #21 wine in the world on Wine Spectator's 2016 Top 100. This wine heads our over delivery tier, having received a 94 point score for the 2013. Tastes great too..

This Syrah is immediately elegant, exotic, and highly perfumed. With initial notes of mulberry and black currants that lead into a spicy complexity with hints of olive tapenade, white pepper, and a gorgeous finish.
