TASTING NOTES:

A new release, the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Anam Cara Reserve checks in as 93.4% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4.5% Petit Verdot and even smaller amounts of Cabernet Franc and Malbec. It's another gorgeous wine from this estate offering fabulous cassis and black raspberry-like fruit along with well-integrated spice and dried flower nuances. It's pure, medium to full-bodied, has fine tannins, flawless balance, and a great, great finish. 94pts - Jeb Dunnuck

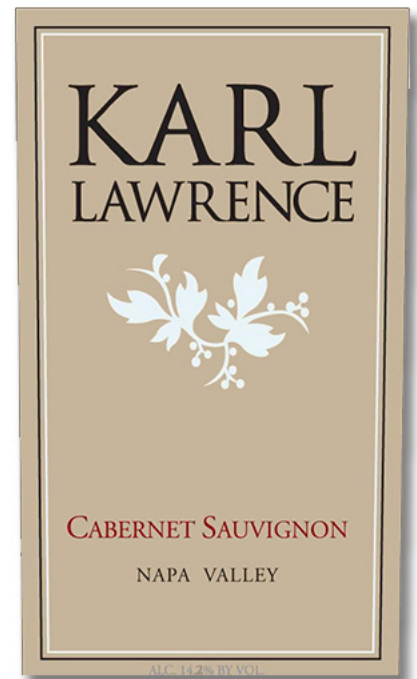
Making premium wine starts with this Valley and great grapes. Karl Lawrence Cellars has sourced grapes from some of the finest vineyards in the Napa Valley since 1991. These vineyards include Gary Morisoli, Herb Lamb, Henry Brothers' Ranch, Healy, Stagecoach, Beckstoffer's To Kalon and Dr. Crane.

Since 2013, we have been sourcing grapes from the Pocaí Vineyard in the Calistoga Appellation, and the Fig Tree Vineyard at the base of Howell Mountain, in the St. Helena Appellation.

POST PARADE 2019 'STRETCH DRIVE' CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES:

This vintage of Stretch Drive is another big winner, showing off a viscous, concentrated palate, and expressive, nuanced aromatics. In the glass, the wine exhibits a deep purple hue with a dark violet halo. Interwoven aromatic notes suggest currant, loam, pine bough and lilac. The palate experience offers a pleasing balancing act of dark, complex fruit and finely-integrated tannin. This bold fruit and structure are complimented by a bright acidity on the back end, drawing out to a long, floral finish..

WINERY INFO:

Post Parade founder, Brook Smith, developed his love of Napa Cabernet thanks to Master Sommelier, Kevin Vogt, and vineyard owners, Paul and Suzie Frank. A partner in several bourbon ventures in Kentucky, Smith saw creating a Napa Cabernet Sauvignon as the natural next step in his luxury beverage investments.

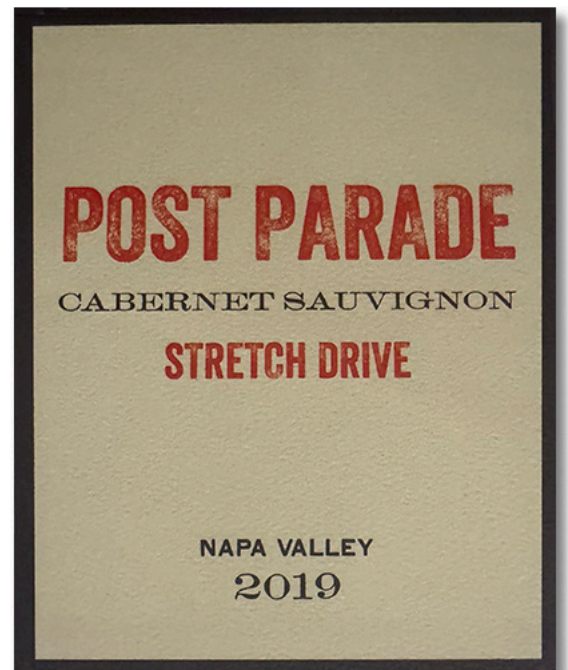
