FOXEN VINEYARD 2018 CHARDONNAY BLOCK UU, BIEN NACIDO VINEYARD SANTA MARIA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES: This is an elegant Chardonnay that displays fresh, bright aromatics of lime peel, guava, beeswax and lemon zest backed by hints of honeysuckle and jasmine. Flavors of key lime pie coat the palate with a hint of hazelnut, and its minerality is nicely balanced with soft acidity.

WINERY INFO: Bill Wathen and Dick Dore have been making wine together since 1985, when they founded Foxen Winery & Vineyard at the historic Rancho Tinaquaic in northern Santa Barbara County. Since that time, their dedication has remained the same - the creation of very small production, sustainably-farmed, vineyard-focused wines using a “minimalist” approach to winemaking. Foxen is named in memory of William Benjamin Foxen, an English sea captain and Dick’s great-great grandfather, who came to Santa Barbara in the early 1800s and purchased the Rancho Tinaquaic.




ZEITGEIST CELLARS 2021 TROUSSEAU GRIS FANUCCHI WOOD ROAD VYD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

TASTING NOTES: The super focused 2021 Trousseau Gris is fresh and precise. Like always, vibrancy is the hallmark of this rare and fun varietal. This vintage is replete with notes of lemon verbena, star fruit and bergamot. A clean and concise minerality anchors the mid palate. Ready to ship in late March and ready to enjoy the second it hits your doorstep.

WINERY INFO: A native of the Jura region, Trousseau Gris is a true “Grey” grape and can make either white wines or slightly colored wines. We choose to press the grapes the moment they

arrive at the winery, opting for a fresh white wine style. Pressed lightly to avoid any bitterness, the juice is transferred to stainless steel barrels. The wines ferment at low temperatures and can take as long as 6 weeks to finish. We age the wine on its lees, and assemble and bottle the blend in February. The wine does not go through malo-lactic fermentation.
