TASTING NOTES:

The wine offers rich aromas of blackberry and cassis, followed by sophisticated hints of violets, white pepper, and rose petals. The complex flavors peak in a burst of vibrant, succulent blue fruit with savory nuances of graphite and dark chocolate. Nicely proportioned with soft, rounded tannins and precise acidity, ending with a prolonged and enduring finish.

Crown Point Vineyards is located in an idyllic location 12 miles north of the Pacific Ocean, nestled between the Santa Ynez coastal range and the San Rafael mountains. The vineyard benefits from a mild Mediterranean climate, perfect for growing a diverse range of grape varieties, including Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Petit Verdot, and Sauvignon Blanc.

The stress-inducing rocky soil, combined with the climate, creates a unique balance ideal for producing exceptional wines. Crown Point Vineyards is committed to sustainable viticulture practices, ensuring that the grapes are grown in harmony with the environment. This approach results in distinguished wines that showcase the terroir of the vineyard and reflect the highest standards of quality and craftsmanship.

KRUPP BROTHERS 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 'THE WHEELMAN' NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES:

This wine invites with captivating aromas of violet, anise and luscious plum giving way to the warmth of clove and cardamom. The palate is lush and round, with flavors of milk chocolate spiced by cardamom, seamlessly leading to a lingering finish laced with vanilla. Pair with hamachi collar, a patty melt, or a Cobb salad with blue cheese. Drink now through 2040.

WINERY INFO:

Our winery is the dream of two brothers who nurtured a passion for wine over decades. After setting down roots in the San Francisco Bay Area, Jan - an internist with a bustling medical practice - pursued his winemaking as a hobby for 15 years. While continuing to commute to his medical practice, Jan moved to Napa in 1991 and began to tend grapes – first planting a vineyard surrounding his family’s house and then with the help

of Bart, he would develop what would become one of Napa’s most iconic vineyards, Stagecoach.

In 1999, Jan and Bart founded Krupp Brothers, producing their first vintage: An extraordinary Cabernet Sauvignon. Our wines begin at the source – fruit from select blocks that have been carefully chosen by Jan. Today, each wine in our collection – from our mountain Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignons to our Rhone-style Syrah and Tempranillo-based red – embody the vision and passion that guided the two brothers.
