DYER VINEYARD 2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON DYER VINEYARD DIAMOND MOUNTAIN DISTRICT, NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES:

Deep black cherry fruit, graphite, dried herbs and lavender laced thru with savory notes. A graceful, even pretty, balance and weight with a lengthy finish. Muscular tannins on the palate promise a long life.

WINERY INFO:

Through Dyer Vineyard and Dyer Straits Wine Co., Bill and Dawnine Dyer bring the rich history and intense flavors of Diamond Mountain Cabernet to life. The Napa Valley winery in the Diamond Mountain District combines their expertise and experience in one wine- Dyer Vineyard, Diamond Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon- a celebration of California's storied wine-making history. Bill and Dawnine's unique perspective and knowledge of wine derives from decades of winemaking, both in the prestigious Napa Valley and around the world. Together they represent more than 80 years of experience in the wine industry. In 1996, they planted Dyer Vineyard and started Dyer Straits Wine Co with the goal of bringing focus on the exceptional terroir and extraordinary wines of Napa Valley's "jewel" on Diamond Mountain.

Dyer Vineyard is a 2.3 acre vineyard situated on a bench, mid-slope on Diamond Mountain. The exposition is north facing and the slope is 7-10%. The site is probably an ancient land slide - rocky with fine volcanic soil and gravel ranging from ash to richer red soils. The vineyard was planted in 1993.

Dyer favors a restrained, balanced style of winemaking that cultivates the unique characteristics of the vineyard. To that end, they have refined the varietal selection to Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Diamond Mountain is famous for wines of great longevity, minerality, and huge tannins. All efforts in both the vineyard and the winery are focused on optimizing the development of ripe tannins in the grapes and supple tannins in the wine. When possible, the 3 varieties are harvested on the same day and co-fermented. Dyer Cabernet is aged in French oak for a total of 20 months.





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ELYSE WINERY **2018 CABERNET SAUVIGNON** **ELYSE VINEYARD** **YOUNTVILLE, NAPA VALLEY**

TASTING NOTES: This single vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is produced from our 1.3 acre estate vineyard and quickly displays the unique terroir of Hoffman Lane. Notes of Bing cherry and saddle leather dominate the nose, with just a kiss of menthol and mint to remind you of this vineyard's unique sense of place. Vibrant acidity mixed with refined tannins will allow this wine to be enjoyed for decades to come.

WINERY INFO: In 1987, Ray & Nancy started Elyse Winery with 286 cases of Zinfandel from the Morisoli Vineyard, which is still a cornerstone vineyard source for the winery. After a decade of nomadic winemaking at various custom crush facilities, in 1997 they purchased a small winery and vineyard on Hoffman Lane, the home of Elyse Winery and tasting room. Situated within the Yountville AVA, (American Viticultural Area) with the coastal breezes of San Pablo Bay and the Pacific Ocean, it is one of the coolest regions in the Napa Valley. This allows a long and cool growing season that contributes to the complexity and refinement of the Elyse Estate Cabernet Sauvignon. A grove of giant eucalyptus trees borders one side of the vineyard leaving a signature aroma in the wines, and the clay based soils make for fine grain tannins and balanced wines that are immediately approachable.

Situated within the Yountville AVA, (American Viticultural Area) with the coastal breezes of San Pablo Bay and the Pacific Ocean, it is one of the coolest regions in the Napa Valley.
