

## ADELAIDA VINEYARDS 2020 PINOT NOIR HMR ESTATE VINEYARD ADELAIDA DISTRICT, PASO ROBLES

### TASTING NOTES:

These esteemed old vines display the compelling attributes of new-world fruit entwined around old-world flavor and structure. Fruit forward aromas of black cherry, raspberry, and musky rose combine beautifully with savory allspice and rich earth. The rare soil combination, over limestone clay, creates both finesse and structure. Upon release, the wine is vibrant and juicy, this flavor profile originates from the natural bright fruit acidity of grapes grown in limestone soils. Overall, one of the more graceful vintages of HMR to sip and savor. Drink now through 2029.

### WINERY INFO:

Adelaida is built on a vision of excellence: for wine, for community, and for minimal ecological impact. The land known as Hilltop Ranch, purchased in 1971 by founders Don and Elizabeth Van Steenwyk, has humble beginnings as a peaceful family sanctuary. Through decades of meticulous planning and creativity, the family built what is now known as Adelaida Vineyards & Winery.

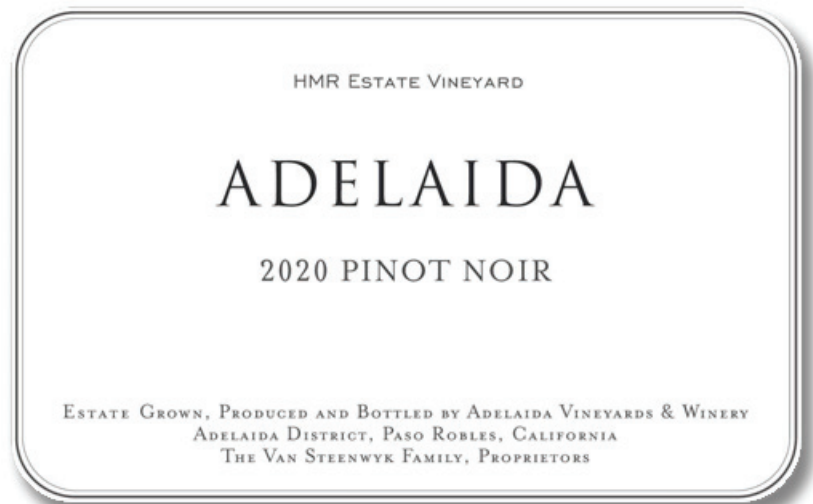
Purchased in 1994 by Adelaida, Hoffman Mountain Ranch (HMR) Vineyard is one of the most celebrated and historic vineyards in California and home to the Central Coast's oldest Pinot Noir vineyard. The rare, old vine Pinot Noir (34 acres) dating back to 1964 anchors this property. Due to its unique microclimate, this pioneering vineyard, located 14 miles from the Pacific Ocean, is particularly well-suited to growing Burgundian grape varieties.

## LAVINEA WINERY 2021 PINOT NOIR EOLA-AMITY HILLS, OREGON

### TASTING NOTES:

This wine highlights the complex diversity that is the Eola-Amity Hills and delivers on the character of the 2021 vintage. The year began with an epic ice storm in the winter, followed by rain at flowering, then a record-setting heat event. After that, we experienced a relatively dry growing season with a few heat events in August, followed by welcome rains and a cooling period in September and October. Typical of the vintage the wine is rich with generous fruit that remains fresh from practiced restraint in the cellar.

40% Pommard and 667 clones and co-fermented, 60% 777 and 115 clones and co-fermented, taken from 4 different blocks in the Eola-Amity Hills. 4- and 6-day cold soak, no inoculations, pressed to tank for settling, racked to barrel then allowed for ML to finish. Mix of once and twice filled French oak barrels.

### WINERY INFO:

Founded in 2014, Lavinea is committed to becoming a benchmark producer of wines of place in the Willamette Valley, crafting wines that represent the purest voice of site-specific terroir from each of our vineyards.

The Eola-Amity Hills AVA is contained within the Willamette Valley AVA and is located northwest of Salem, Oregon's state capitol. The majority of the region's vineyard sites exist at elevations between 250-700 feet. Wines produced from this region offer high acidity, firm structure and a darker, edgier personality.
